

GENUS: *BRADYCALANUS*

This genus resembles *Megacalanus* but antenna 1 is apparently not modified for grasping in the male and the setae on the terminal parts of maxilla 2 are scythe-like and densely ciliated. Maxilla 1 with the following combination of spines and setae; inner lobes 1, 2 and 3 with 13, 4 and 2 setae respectively; basipod with 4 setae; endopod segments 1, 2 and 3 with 2, 1 and 5 setae respectively; exopod with 11 setae; outer lobes 2 and 1 with 1 and 9 setae respectively. Leg 1 basipod segment 2 without a hooked spine. Male left leg 5 exopod segment 2 has a simple spine without hairs on the inner border.
